

OUR PRESCHOOL DAY

Time	Activity	We Are Learning...
8:45	Arrival & Morning Routine	Students complete the morning routine as they arrive. Students hang up their backpacks, say goodbye to their family, check in, find their name and then find an activity.
9:10	Circle Time	During circle time, we explore the calendar, review our daily schedule, meet the Letter Person, and say the Pledge of Allegiance. We also count, read books, sing and dance. We will also use this time for Star of the Week and Show and Share.
9:30	Centers	Students will choose centers to work/play in with a friend or independently. Students will rotate through different centers throughout the morning. Centers include art and writing, blocks, table games, sensory table, puzzles, books, and dramatic play. During centers, students are developing many skills, including fine motor, literacy, math, science, and social skills.
	Small Group	During centers, students will also work with the teacher in a small group. New projects and activities will be introduced at this time.
10:15	Handwashing & snack time	All students wash their hands and use the bathroom if needed. We also eat and drink snack during this time. During this time, children are learning table manners, social skills, and math concepts. After snack, children may read a book or work on a puzzle
10:40	Big Room	Students will explore various gross motor activities in our "Big Room". Some examples include slide, balance beam, bean bag toss, basketball, etc.
11:00	Large Group	Large group time consists of group games or activities completed as a group. These activities may include writing, numbers, or games.
11:30	Music & Movement	We will sing songs, play instruments, and use music to explore our preschool themes, along with letters and numbers. Students will also review their day and prepare for dismissal.
11:45	Dismissal	Students will pack up their backpacks, put coats on, and be dismissed to parents as they arrive.

Our preschool day has a mix of student lead, play based, and teacher directed lessons and activities through the Letter People Curriculum. We infuse movement throughout the day and take the child's attention span into consideration as well. This is our daily routine. The routine may be adjusted to fit students' need, situation (fire drills, etc.) and classroom events.
